KEYNOTE SPEAKER Nick Walters – OSHA Regional Administrator



Nick began his career with the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) in 1992 in the Aurora, Illinois Area Office. He worked as a Compliance Officer in Aurora and the Peoria, Illinois Area Office for 13 years. Nick also served as the Audit and Analysis Team Leader in the Chicago Regional Office and then returned to Peoria as the Area Director.

Nick was named the Deputy Regional Administrator for the Chicago Regional Office in 2010 and Regional Administrator in 2012. In this position, he is responsible for overseeing all OSHA programs within a six-state region consisting of Illinois, Indiana, Michigan, Minnesota, Ohio, and Wisconsin. He holds a Bachelor of Science in Industrial Technology from Northern Illinois University in DeKalb, Illinois, and is also a certified CHST.
